### 1º Year Dentistry 100% English

Classes begin September 18<sup>th</sup>, 2017.

Limit of credits enrolled per academic year = **72 ECTS limit** (under no circumstances can more credits be enrolled in one academic year). Credit minimum to enroll **30 ECTS** per academic year.

**Students should not enroll in Idioma Moderno if they have not yet obtained their language requirement.** This subject should be enrolled in the year you will obtain the level requirement through the Language Center courses.

It is the student's responsibility to **plan for the requirements of the Idioma Moderno** subject by visiting the Language Center and understanding the classes needed to obtain their required level. [Language Center](#)

All students studying the Dentistry Degree 100% in English must reach their Spanish level requirement through the Language Center in the following ways:

**Student with university numbers from 2012 and prior:** Students are required to pass the Spanish B1 exam administered by the Language Center.

**Student with university numbers from 2013 forward:** Students must reach their required level of Spanish through Language Center courses as well as the completion of the "Español Para Odontólogos" course also offered at the Language Center. Please keep in mind the following regarding the level courses:

- **Level Requirement of B1: Student University numbers between 2012 and 2015**
- **Level Requirement of B2: Student University numbers from 2016 forward.**

The level requirement for the Idioma Moderno course for students who were registered prior to the 2016/2017 academic course is to complete level **B1**; for students registered in 2016/2017 and forward, the required level to complete is **B2**.

Limit of credit enrolled per academic year = 72 ECTS limit (under no circumstances can more credits be enrolled in one academic year).  
Credit minimum to enroll 30 ECTS per academic year.

For all subjects enrolled in the same year, the group must be the same for all subjects.

Subjects enrolled that pertain to different years of study must be registered in opposing shifts (timetable).

NO clashing timetables will be allowed. This means that students cannot register in courses that overlap in their timetables.

For students who are registering only theory courses for 4° year or 5° year subjects (meaning that no clinic courses for those corresponding years are being registered), must register the **special groups** provided for this situation.

In order to be eligible to register for **TFG (Final Thesis subject)**, you must have registered ALL pending credits in your Dentistry degree (and this can only be done if the student is within the allowed credits for enrollment).

NO changes to registration can be made until the specific dates for registration modifications. Only students with special reasoning (appears within [university guidelines](#) for changes in registration) can make modifications to their registration even during those specific dates.

Registration modification dates for the 2017/2018 academic year: First semester from September 13th to the 24th 2017; Second semester from January 29th to February 9th 2018.
