All my schooling was under the French system, a guarantee of my knowledge of French, English and German languages (German was an elective subject in secondary school) as well as my cultural background, critical capacity, and reflection and communication skills. In addition, I studied Japanese in private schools, a complement that reinforces this uncommon profile among teachers in the Valencian Community; also key is the professional facet, which I have kept active since the beginning of my teaching and research career and which has exceeded two decades.

After graduating in Translation and Interpreting, I obtained the Monbusho pre-doctoral research grant (Japanese Ministry of Education), which is only awarded to excellent projects in the case of Human and Social Sciences, and thanks to it and my participation in the research project of Prof. Hiroto Ueda at the University of Tokyo I discovered the areas of research that interested me the most. The result of this research became not my doctoral thesis, but a collection of manuals for learning Japanese through reading comics. However, the aim is didactic and it represents an ideal training tool for translation students who wish to translate from Japanese.

I did my doctorate years later, as I wanted to work in all the areas of translation that interested me in order to provide professional experience to university teaching (which the examining board of my thesis valued very positively). Thus, I created a translation agency in 2003, which is still active and employs dozens of translators, in addition to offering curricular internships for undergraduate and master's degree students, with a high percentage of professional insertion at the end of the programs.

After earning my doctorate with the highest qualification after twenty years of professional experience, my teaching career is now 6 years old and my scientific production is focused on translation as a professional activity and on the training of translators in accordance with the needs of the industry. As can be seen from the list of publications, I began to publish and participate in conferences and seminars in the first years of my doctorate, bringing a new, applied and pioneering approach to translatology that specifically addressed the translator and the process, and not only the translation as a product. This is the subject of my doctoral thesis, which sheds light on the reality of the industry and the processes of the different translation modalities from professional experience.

In recent years I have continued my research in the area of audiovisual and comic book translation. Some of my publications are old, but they are equally valid today because they are descriptive studies that, in perspective, show the evolution of the translation process. Currently, in the line of research on transmedia and reception, GETRA conducts case studies on the professional translation of manga and anime and transmedia publishing products.

On the other hand, in my professional career I founded and direct the publishing house Taketombo Books (2012), which is interested in the post-monocultural order in the world and publishes, among others, scientific works. As a result of my experience in publishing, I have also designed, planned and coordinated the Master's Degree in Editorial Translation and Book Packaging at UEV.

Finally, my intention, after 25 years in the profession, is to give priority to teaching and research in order to finally bring all this knowledge to the classroom.
